Aloha by Jean Manis

1. Cut a 4 1/4" x 11" piece of Sugar Cube cardstock and fold in half to create a cardbase.
2. To create the background, apply Lollipop, Strawberry Milkshake and Candy Corn inks (starting top to bottom) to a 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" Sugar Cube cardstock panel with Clarity Stencil Brushes. Attach the panel to the cardbase.
3. Die cut Sugar Cube cardstock with the largest die in Stitched Rectangle Stacklets. Cut a mask from Ray of Sunshine Cutting Plate and adhere. Apply inks - Potato Chip, Lemon Meringue, Candy Corn, Pumpkin - through stencil with Clarity Stencil Brushes. Work from the center out beginning with the lightest ink.
4. Remove the mask and set aside.
5. Die cut Cookie Monster cardstock with the largest rectangle in Stitched Rectangle Stacklets set. Die cut with Beach Border (left section).
6. Die cut Oreo cardstock with the largest rectangle in the Stitched Rectangle Stacklets set. Die cut with Beach Border (right section). Trim off any of the left section. Attach small piece of Poppy Seed cardstock behind the beach hut door.
7. Using a MISTI, stamp and heat-emboss, with white embossing powder, the "Aloha" sentiment from the Simply Stamped - Pineapple set on the Oreo cardstock piece.
8. Attach Ray of Sunshine background and Beach Border layers together with double-sided adhesive. Attach it to the cardbase.
9. Die cut Little Bits - Flip Flops from cardstock colored with Candy Corn and with Lollipop inks. Assemble with liquid adhesive and attach to the card with foam adhesive.
