## Sip, Sip Hooray

- 1. Cut a 4 1/4" x 11" piece of Sugar Cube cardstock and fold in half for a cardbase.
- 2. Cut a 5 1/2" x 4 1/4" piece of Salt Water Taffy cardstock for a cardfront.
- 3. Cut a 5 1/4" x 4" piece of Sugar Cube cardstock. Cut a piece of foam adhesive sheet slightly smaller. Do NOT adhere, but lay on top of each and cut a circle using the Stitched Circle Stacklets. (**NOTE:** You will **not** need the adhesive circle that remains, but you **will** be using the Sugar Cube circle that remains.)
- 4. Emboss the remaining Sugar Cube panel with Bead Board Embossing Folder and then use the foam adhesive sheet to adhere this piece to the Salt Water Taffy cardfront.
- 5. On the Stitched Circle piece, use stencil brushes to apply Salt Water Taffy ink at the top, Sprinkles ink in the middle, then Granny Smith ink at the bottom. Adhere inside the circle opening, directly to the Salt Water Taffy cardfront.
- 6. Stamp the cart, umbrella and lemonade from Sip, Sip Hooray on Sugar Cube cardstock. Color with Copics, adding Wink of Stella to the ice cubes. Stamp the top part of the umbrella on the yellow polka dot paper from the Build a Scene Paper Pack. Trim closely and adhere over the stamped image. Die cut all the pieces and assemble the cart.
- 7. Cut the smallest Banner Stacklets 1 from Poppy Seed cardstock. Stamp the sentiment with Sugar Cube ink. Trim the banner to fit.
- 8. Assemble as shown. Embellish with a few blue sequins from Hello Happiness sequins.
