## TE Stamps:

Small packages

## TE Dies:

Tin Topper  
Giftcard Frame  
Little Bits - Gingerbread Man  
Little Bits - Coffee Cup  
Little Bits - Sprinkles Confetti  
Heart Stacklets

## Ink:

Sugar Cube

## TE Cardstock:

Shimmer White  
Peapod

## Other:

Snow Flurries Sequins

Build a Scene - Christmas Paper Pack  
White Embossing Powder

1. Die-cut the following:
  - Tin Topper out of Shimmer White and out of Foam Adhesive
  - Gift Card Frame out of Peapod and out of a piece of acrylic
  - Heart out of Mulled Wine
  - Little Bits - Gingerbread Man out of Toffee. Also the pieces are out of Mocha, Mulled Wine and Cupcake but look at the Tip later as to a good way to do this.
  - Little Bits - Coffee Cup out of patterned paper
  - Little Bits - Sprinkles Confetti out of Mulled Wine, Cupcake, Toffee and Granny Smith
2. Line up the White Tin Topper on top of the Peapod Gift Card Frame in order to place the sentiment. Stamp and heat emboss with white. Set this piece aside for now.
3. Adhere the acrylic to the top of the Foam Adhesive Tin Topper. **TIP:** When you need to line up something perfectly, pull back just a corner or a side of the paper backing covering the adhesive. Line up the piece to adhere starting on the side that still has paper backing. Press it down from that side to the side with adhesive so that only that

- corner or a side ends up being adhered. Reach in between and pull off the remaining paper backing. All will be perfectly aligned!
4. Flip this piece upside down and fill with all of the Little Bits - Sprinkles Confetti and some Snow Flurries Sequins.
5. Adhere the stamped Peapod piece to the back of the shaker making sure the sentiment is in the right place. (Remember the TIP from the earlier step.) Set aside for now.
6. Place the various die-cuts as shown on the Shimmer White Tin Topper. I used dimensional adhesive under the coffee cup. Add a sprinkle of small sequins. **ANOTHER TIP:** The little pieces in the Gingerbread Man can be difficult to manage. First adhere the Toffee Gingerbread Man (on top of the heart.) Add small dots of liquid adhesive where you want the Mocha pieces to be (a fine-tipped applicator is recommended) then cut another Gingerbread Man out of Mocha - leaving all pieces in the die. Flip the die over on top of the Toffee piece. Use a paper piercer or other fine tip to push the appropriate Mocha pieces out of the die into the empty spot where you've put some adhesive. Repeat with Mulled Wine and Cupcake.
7. Adhere this decorated piece of Shimmer White to the acrylic.
8. Adhere the entire pieces to the Small Hinged Tin.
