Pray, Wait, Trust by Keia Shipp-Smith

1. Cut a top-folding A2 card base from Lavender Glaze cardstock.
2. Cut a panel 4" X 5 1/4" from Sugar Cube cardstock.
 - Emboss panel using Braided embossing folder. Using a blending tool, ink edges with Lavender Glaze ink.
 - Using Label Stacklets 6 (second-largest die), die-cut two labels from Sugar Cube cardstock.
 - Take one of the labels, and using the Stitched Circle Stacklets (third from the largest die), die-cut a circle into the panel.
 - Take the second label panel and ink it with Lavender Glaze and Potato Chip ink.
 - Using foam adhesive, adhere the two panels together and set aside.
3. Using the Wildflower Bouquet and coordinating die, stamp, color and die-cut the floral bouquet. Color bouquet with Copic markers.
4. Stamp the sentiment "Pray, Wait, Trust" onto a piece of Sugar Cube cardstock (3/4 x 4) using Oreo ink.
 - Mat the banner onto Lavender Glaze cardstock (7/8 x 4).
5. Using the In Flight Overlays, die-cut three butterflies from vellum paper.
6. Adhere embossed panel to the A2 card front. Using adhesive, adhere the label with floral bouquet to the card front. Attach sentiment banner at the bottom. Using liquid adhesive, adhere vellum butterflies.
